- All students at Dietz have the opportunity to receive free breakfast and lunch every day. There is no need to fill out applications.
- K-8 grade students are NOT allowed to wear any hooded sweaters inside the classroom and building.
- NO CROCS are allowed on school grounds.

- Cell phones: Students are not permitted to keep cen phones on their person once they come to school. They can turn it into the office or place it in a pouch in their backpack.
