- School start: 7:45 a.m. for ALL students.
- K-5 students: dismiss at 1:55 p.m. on Mon., Tues., Thurs., and Fri.
- 6th 8th graders are dismissed at 2:45 p.m. on Mon., Tues., Thurs., and Fri.
- Wednesday: K-5 are dismissed at 12:55 pm and $6^{th} 8^{th}$ is dismissed at 1:55pm
- All students at Dietz receive free breakfast and lunch every day. There is no need to fill out applications.
- Cell phones: Students are not permitted to keep cell phones on their person once they come to school. They can turn it into the office or place it in a pouch in their backpack.

• Drinks: Students can only bring water to school or a small juice with lunch. No soft drinks, energy drinks, coffee, Gatorades etc. in the morning or during classes

• Snacks: Only single serve chips or snacks for LUNCH. NO big bags.

• In the morning parents will drop off students at the front of the school, only students and staff are allowed to enter the building in the morning.

• Late pick-ups: Parents, I understand emergencies occur. If you will be late picking up your student(s) call the front office at 731-4000. We need to work together!
